



## Finance and Accounting

Effective January 1, 2015, some counties in Florida will have new sales tax rates in effect. For example, Seminole County's sales tax rate will increase from 6% to 7% and Brevard County's sales tax rate will increase from 6% to 6.5%. Orange County's sales tax rate will remain at 6.5%. When making sales to other counties, please refer to the discretionary sales surtax information provided by the Florida Department of Revenue to ensure that sales tax is being assessed at the correct rate.
